PYRAMIDS are massive structures that were built thousands of years ago by ancient civilizations such as the EGYPTIANS and the MEXICANS. The pyramids are known for their enormous size and INTRICATE designs, and they are considered to be some of the greatest architectural achievements of the ancient world. The construction of pyramids was a massive undertaking that required thousands of workers and many years of effort. The process of building a pyramid involved several steps. Each step was carefully planned and executed to ensure the stability and LONGEVITY of the finished structure.

The first step in the CONSTRUCTION of a pyramid was the creation of a solid FOUNDATION. The foundation had to be strong enough to support the WEIGHT of the pyramid, which could reach up to several million tons. In ancient Egypt, the foundation was typically made of a mixture of sand and gravel, which was COMPACTED to form a solid base. In some cases, the foundation was also lined with stones to prevent the sand from SHIFTING.

Once the foundation was complete, the walls of the pyramid could be constructed. Large blocks of stone that could weigh up to 80 tons each, were usually QUARRIED (extracted) from nearby mountains. Then they were TRANSPORTED to the construction site and carefully placed in position to form the walls of the pyramid. Some quarries were over 100 km (60 miles) away from the building sites. The blocks were shaped and fitted together with great PRECISION, creating an incredibly strong and stable structure. The process of building the walls was repeated until the pyramid was complete, with each layer of blocks slightly smaller than the one below it to create the pyramid's SLOPE.

In addition to the walls, the INTERIOR of the pyramid was also constructed. Passages, chambers, and SHAFTS were carved into the stone, providing access to the burial chamber where the members of the royal family would be ENTOMBED (buried). The walls of the interior chambers were often lined with gold, silver, or other PRECIOUS materials, and the burial chamber was typically filled with valuable treasures and ARTIFACTS. The final step in the construction of a pyramid was the placement of the CAPSTONE. The capstone, which was usually made of solid gold or other precious materials, was placed on top of the pyramid, completing the structure. The capstone served as a symbol of the ancient civilization's technological and architectural PROWESS.

Egyptian pyramids were built as tombs for PHARAOHS, their CONSORTS, and members of the royal family and served as a symbol of their power and wealth. The pyramids were constructed over a period of several hundred years, from around 2630 BCE to around 1640 BCE, during the Old and Middle Kingdom periods of ancient Egypt. The Great Pyramids of GIZA, located near CAIRO, Egypt, are famous and well-preserved. These pyramids, which include the Great Pyramid of Giza, the Pyramid of Khafre (Ca-free), and the Pyramid of Menkaure (Mein-ku-rea), were built as tombs for pharaohs of the Fourth DYNASTY of the Old Kingdom of Egypt. The Great Pyramid of Giza, the largest of the three pyramids, is considered to be one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. It was originally 146 meters (481 feet) tall, but today, it stands at 138 meters (455 feet) tall due to the loss of its PYRAMIDION or capstone.
